Dear Parents,

Friday, November 9 is our school JOG-A-THON. This is always one of the kids' favorite events of the school year. This year the theme is the *Olympics*, chosen by last year's fundraising winners, the first grade class.

The goal of the JOG-A-THON is to empower our kids to become more in charge of their school fundraiser, teaching them to be good citizens while exercising and having fun.

We are also aiming for 100% participation and any size gift helps. The money raised will go toward technology, classroom supplies, grade-level field trips, after school enrichment, teacher training, athletic equipment, performing arts resources, and tuition assistance – all important elements for our kids' education.

Here are a few of the details:

1. **Classroom station decorations:** Each class will be decorating their own stations under the school-wide theme of the Olympics. This project will be part of in-class art.
2. **T-shirts and allowed attire:** On the day of the Jog-A-Thon our kids will be showing off their new Jog-A-Thon t-shirts with the blue school PE shorts. Students are allowed to wear crazy socks.
3. **Weekly raffles:** There will be three weeks of weekly raffles occurring on Fridays (Oct. 19, 26, and Nov. 2). Your kids can either do a one time contribution of \$150 so that he/she is included in all three raffles. Or for \$50 your child will be included in one raffle.
4. There is **one more raffle on the day of the event.** Children who raised \$250 or more will be entered to win one of three fabulous prizes: XBOX One, Nintendo Switch, or 2 Disneyland Parkhopper tickets. Money must be turned in Thursday, Nov. 8 at 8 am to be entered to win.
5. The class that raises the most money for our school (per average) will get to choose next year's school wide theme (with approval from school).
6. The Jog-A-Thon will end at around 12:15 pm and children will be dismissed.
